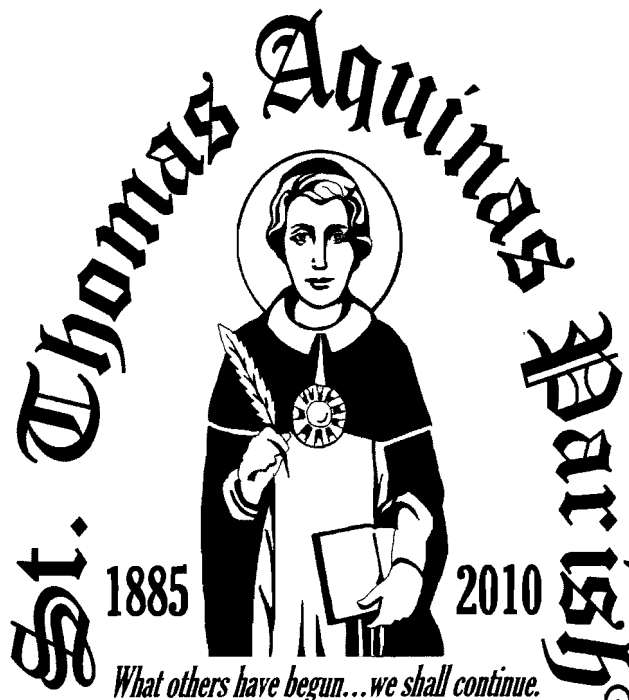
**We Welcome You To
